

## Instructions For Sending Us Your Yarn

Thank you for trusting Side Hustle Socks with your yarn!

1. Make sure the order form is filled out completely. For EACH additional skein, use the back of this form to include the name of the yarn, the number of stitches (60, 72, or 84), and whether or not you want 30 grams of yarn withheld for the heels, toes, and cuffs.

2. Put the yarn and order form into an envelope, and pop it into the mail to the address below. That's it!

When we receive your order, we will carefully inspect the yarn and prepare it for cranking. We can work with most lace weight, fingering weight, and some light sport weight yarns, but yarn which breaks easily or has an uneven texture does not work well in the machine. If we are unable to successfully crank it we will return it to you. We can deal with knots if we encounter them.

When your tubes are finished, we'll send you an electronic invoice for the tubes and postage cost. As soon as we have payment confirmation, we'll drop your tubes into the mail. We ship USPS First Class unless you request something different.

The cost is \$20 for each 100-130 gram skein, or \$16 each for 5 or more skeins.
